

<b>FACTS</b>	<b>WHAT DOES COMMUNITY BANKS OF COLORADO, A DIVISION OF BANK MIDWEST, N.A. DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?</b>
<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Social Security number</li> <li>▪ Income</li> <li>▪ Account Balances</li> <li>▪ Payment history</li> <li>▪ Credit history</li> <li>▪ Credit score</li> </ul> When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Community Banks of Colorado chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

<b>Who is providing this notice?</b>	Community Banks of Colorado, Community Banks of Northern California
What we do	
<b>How does Community Banks of Colorado protect my personal information?</b>	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured file and buildings.
<b>How does Community Banks of Colorado collect my personal information</b>	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ open an account or apply for a loan</li> <li>▪ use your credit or debit card or make deposits or withdrawals from your account</li> <li>▪ give us your contact information</li> </ul> <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
<b>Why can't I limit all sharing?</b>	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes--information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>▪ affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>▪ sharing for non-affiliates to market to you</li> </ul> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.</p>
Definitions	
<b>Affiliates</b>	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>Our affiliates include Community Banks of Colorado and Community Banks of Northern California.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Nonaffiliates</b>	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>Community Banks of Colorado does not share with non-affiliates so they can market you.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Joint marketing</b>	<p>A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>Community Banks of Colorado does not jointly market.</i></li> </ul>
Other important information	
<b>Special Notice For State Residents</b>	
You may have other privacy protections under applicable state laws. To the extent these state laws apply, we will comply with them when we share information about you.	
<b>For California residents:</b> In accordance with California law, we will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of our corporate family, except as permitted by law: for example, with your consent or to service your account. We will limit sharing among our companies to the extent required by California law.
